Mar 6th: "Sanctuary" -- Rev. Chris Jimmerson The UU church I serve in Austin became a sanctuary church for an immigrant facing deportation to a country where her life would be in danger should she be returned to it. We will explore the tradition and the current state of the sanctuary movement, as well as how it can be transformative for both the persons taking sanctuary and the churches that provide it. Mar 13th: "What's GMO?" -- Monica Rude will be talking about genetically modified foods -- including a brief history -- and the associated chemical, Roundup; emerging evidence of their impact on human and livestock health, as well the health of microbes in soil and fresh water. Lastly, she will provide guidelines for those who choose to not eat these foods. Monica became interested in genetic modification & corporatization of our food systems a few years ago & started writing articles for the SC Food Coop newsletter, the *Garbanzo Gazette*. She is an herbalist and gardener on a campaign to promote cooking from scratch, as a way to promote health, family and community.

Mar 20th: "Goddess Energy"-- Ardene Rickman
A reflection on the impact of female energy on religion, creativity, and all humanity and an appreciation of how it can be utilized to empower all of us to become more aware of its presence in our lives.

Mar 27th: "Easter from a Unitarian Universalist Perspective" - Rev. Azima Lila Forest We'll take a meandering wander through the themes and symbols of this annual spring event and see what's in it for us.
